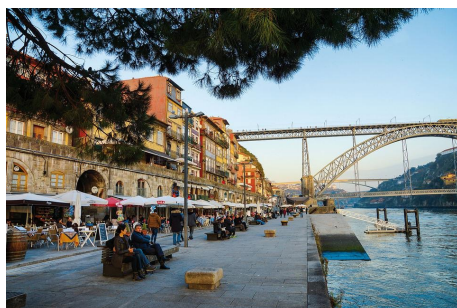

Day 1 – Porto

Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel.

Rest of the day free for rest.

Day 2 – Porto

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day tour to Porto by private transport.

Porto is the second largest city in Portugal and holds a unique beauty. Known for the Port Wine and the Douro River, this is a vibrant city with a huge cultural and artistic life, where in every corner there is something amazing to see and experience.

Places to visit: the historic center that is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Ribeira (an old neighborhood near the river that is part of Porto's beautiful landscape), the Clérigos Tower and the Cathedral (both created in the XVIII century), São Bento Station, the Stock Exchange Palace and, of course, the Port Wine Cellars. Lunch at leisure.

Rest of the afternoon free.

Return to the hotel and overnight.



Day 3 – Porto / Guimarães / Braga / Porto

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Guimarães, Portugal's cradle, to visit the imposing castle, the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança and the historic center that is World Heritage by UNESCO where you will find a maze of beautiful streets and small squares that seem to embrace those who arrive.

After lunch, departure to Braga and visit to this city founded by the Romans at the time of Cesar Augustus and with more than 2000 years of history, visiting the Cathedral (one of the oldest in Europe), the historic center of the city and the Sanctuaries of Sameiro and Bom Jesus (World Heritage by UNESCO and one of the masterpieces of Baroque).

Return to Porto, to the hotel and overnight.

Day 4 – Porto / Aveiro / Coimbra

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure to Aveiro.

Short visit to this city bathed by the channels of the ria and the Costa Nova with its typical houses. After the visit, continuation to Ílhavo and visit to the porcelain museum of Vista Alegre.

We will continue to the region of Bairrada, where you can taste the gastronomic specialty of suckling pig roasted in a wood oven (lunch free).

In the afternoon, continuation to Coimbra and visit to the University, Penedo da Saudade, Sé Velha and Porta da Barbacã.

Overnight.

between the XVI and XVIII centuries and where the Charola of the Knights Templar, the cloister of King Dom Joao III and the Manueline window of the Chapter Room stand out. Descending, we can admire the Church of Saint John the Baptist and the Synagogue. Lunch at leisure.

In the afternoon, we will visit the Castelo de Bode dam, Constância, where Luís de Camões lived, the Castle of Almourol, a castle built by the Knights Templar in the middle of the Tejo River. Then we will pass through the town of Golegã, the horse capital, where we will be able to admire the Manueline portico of the Church of Santa Maria, an obligatory stop on one of the Camino de Santiago.

Return to Tomar in the late afternoon and overnight.



Day 5 – Coimbra / Tomar / Golegã / Constância / Tomar

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure through the interior of the central region with its forests to the city of Tomar, place where the Knights Templar were and headquarters of the Order of Christ, founded by Infante D. Henrique.

Visit the Convent of Christ, built

Dia 6 – Tomar / Fátima / Batalha / Tomar

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day tour to visit two of the main attractions of the region.

Visit to Fátima, religious center of Portugal, where we will find an impressive shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima. Then departure to Batalha to visit its monastery, one of the most extraordinary monuments in Portugal, for its architecture that took about 200 years to build and that is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

After the visit we cross the region of the Serras de Aire e Santo António and visit the Alvados or Santo António caves.

Return to Tomar and rest of the day at leisure.

Day 9 – Lisbon / Sintra / Cascais / Estoril / Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Sintra, a magical place near Lisbon.

Visit to Pena National Palace, the most emblematic monument of Sintra, built on one of the highest points of the region, surrounded by a natural park of untold beauty, followed by a visit to the historical center and National Palace of Sintra. In the afternoon, visit to Cabo da Roca, the westernmost place in Europe, followed by the beautiful town of Cascais, the French Riviera of Portugal. The tour ends with a panoramic tour of Estoril, known for having the largest casino in Europe

and which served as inspiration for the creator of the character of James Bond, the secret agent 007.

Return to Lisbon, to the hotel and accommodation.

Day 10 – Lisbon / Évora / Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure to the Alentejo region, known for its preserved traditions and unique cuisine, to visit the city of Évora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Through the maze of small streets that take us back in time, we will visit the Temple of Diana, the Cathedral, the Giraldo Square and the Chapel of Bones, which is as mystical as it is chilling.

In the afternoon, and on the way back to Lisbon, we will make a stop to visit one of the main producers of national wine where we will visit the winery with wine and olive oil tasting. Arrival in Lisbon, return to the hotel and overnight.

Day 11 – Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day to continue exploring Lisbon.

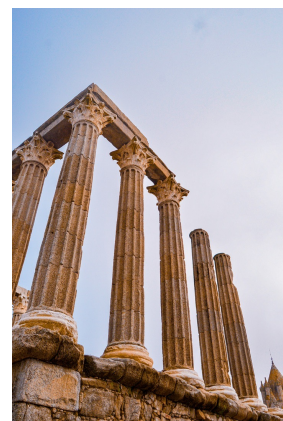
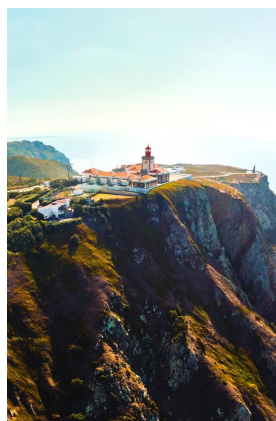
Day 12 – Lisbon
