



10 days / 9 nights

Gastronomic Portugal

From the vineyard to the table



1st day – Porto

Arrival and transfer to the hotel.
In the afternoon, visit to the city. In the evening, typical dinner at a local restaurant in Ribeira do Porto. Return to the hotel and overnight.



2nd day – Porto / Monção / Ponte de Lima / Guimarães

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure towards the Alto Minho region, where the famous green wine is produced from the grape variety "Alvarinho", to start the Vinho Verde Route, visiting the Quinta do Serrade. This farm, with its XVII century manor house, produces high quality wine with several brands. Visit to the vineyards, cellar and tasting. After the visit, continuation through the "greenest province of Portugal" until Santa Marta do Portuzelo and lunch at the typical restaurant Camelo.

In the afternoon, visit to the Cooperative Wine Cellar of Ponte de Lima and tasting of the famous vinho verde adamado. After the visit, continuation to Guimarães, "Portugal Birthplace".

Regional dinner and overnight.



3rd day – Guimarães / Amarante / Pinhão

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and visit to the Guimarães Castle, place where it is said that Portugal was born, the Chapel of S. Miguel, and the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança. Continuation to Casa de Sezim, located in a palace of the fourteenth century, visit to the vineyards, cellar and tasting. Afterwards, continuation to Amarante and lunch at the famous restaurant Zé da Calçada.

In the afternoon, we will leave the green wine routes and continue along the Douro River to the region where Port wine is produced, to Régua, the place where the barrels were once loaded on the Rabelo boats that transported the wine to the cellars in Vila Nova de Gaia.

Regional dinner and accommodation at Quinta da Pacheca or similar.

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4th day – Quinta da Pacheca / Pinhão / Quinta da Pacheca

Breakfast at the hotel and embark for a beautiful boat ride to Pinhão, where you can admire the beautiful vineyards planted in terraces. Arrival and continuation to Vila Real and typical lunch. Visit to Solar de Mateus, palace and gardens.

Return to Quinta da Pacheca and visit to the cellars and wine tasting followed by dinner.

Overnight.



5th day – Quinta da Pacheca / Solar do Vinho do Dão / Buçaco

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure towards Viseu, crossing the mountain ranges that divide the demarcated areas of Port and Dão wines.

Visit to the Solar do Vinho do Dão with tasting and regional lunch. In the afternoon, continuation through the central region crossing the Bussaco Forest and accommodation at Palace Hotel do Buçaco 5*.

Regional dinner at the hotel and overnight.



6th day – Buçaco / Coimbra / Óbidos / Évora

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure towards the Luís Pato Winery, where the best wine of the Bairrada demarcated region is produced. Visit to the vineyards, cellars and tasting.

After the visit, regional lunch in a restaurant in the Bairrada region, famous for its suckling pig roasted in a wood oven.

In the afternoon, continuation to Óbidos, to visit this medieval town and where you can taste the famous Ginjinha (sour cherry liqueur) served in chocolate cups. After the visit, continuation to Évora.

Regional dinner and overnight.

7th day – Évora / Herdade do Esporão / Monsaraz / Évora

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Herdade do Esporão. Visit to the vineyards, winery, tasting and lunch. In the afternoon, visit to the typical village of Monsaraz. Return to Évora.

Regional dinner at Fialho Restaurant or similar and overnight.

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8th day – Évora / Arraiolos / Azeitão / Lisboa

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure to Arraiolos. Arrival in Arraiolos and visit to a carpet factory and to the Arraiolos Carpet Interpretation Center. Lunch at the restaurant O Alpendre.

In the afternoon, continuation through Serra da Arrábida to Azeitão and visit to the Cellars of José Maria da Fonseca with tasting.

After the visit, continuation to Lisbon.

Check in at the hotel and dinner at Varanda de Lisboa Restaurant.

Return to the hotel and overnight.

9th day – Lisboa / Colares / Sintra / Lisboa

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Sintra. Brief stop in this historic town patrimony of Humanity.

Continue to Colares, with visits to vineyards and wineries with tasting of one of the oldest demarcated regions in the country.

After the visit, continuation to the restaurant Taverna dos Trovadores and regional lunch.

In the afternoon, continuation to Lisbon and panoramic visit of the city. At night, transfer to a restaurant for dinner and watch a show of fados. Return to the hotel and overnight.

10th day – Lisboa

Breakfast at the hotel.

At a time to be determined, transfer to Lisbon airport.



Included:

- Transfer from airport to hotel and vice versa;
- Accommodation at 4* hotels or similar, breakfast and lunch plan;
- 8 lunches and 7 dinners;
