Itinerary



DAY 1: Transfer to Madeira

Welcome to Madeira, a stunning island situated in the Atlantic Ocean. Known for its natural beauty, diverse landscapes, and rich cultural heritage, Madeira offers an unforgettable experience to all who visit

DAY 2: Eira/Cristo Rei

This excursion starts at Pico dos Barcelos, offering stunning views of Funchal, before ascending to Eira do Serrado for breathtaking sights of Curral das Freiras. We'll then visit the heart of this charming village before heading to the picturesque Cristo Rei viewpoint on the island's east side.



DAY 3: Full day Porto Moniz

This tour visits Câmara de Lobos and Ribeira Brava, follows the southwest coast to Calheta, and ascends to Paul da Serra. You'll then descend to Porto Moniz, famous for its volcanic pools, before a scenic drive along the north coast to São Vicente. The journey ends with a trip through Encumeada and a stop at Cabo Girão, the world's second-highest sea cliff.

DAY 4: Leisure Day

Relax and explore at your own pace. Stroll through Funchal, visit Monte's gardens, or take a scenic cable car ride. Enjoy a boat tour to spot dolphins or simply unwind with local cuisine and a glass of poncha.



DAY 5: Full day Santana

A spectacular day exploring Madeira's highlights! Visit Pico do Arieiro (1,818m), Ribeiro Frio's trout hatchery, and Santana's iconic "A" framed cottages. Journey along the stunning north coast to Porto da Cruz, Portela, and Machico, before ending in Camacha, known for its wickerwork.

DAY 6: Leisure Day

Spend the day soaking up Madeira's beauty at your own pace. Relax on a scenic terrace with ocean views, explore hidden levada trails, or visit a local winery for a taste of Madeira's famous wine. For a laid-back afternoon, unwind at a seaside café or take a dip in the natural pools of Porto Moniz.



DAY 7: Transfer
