Best of Madeira and Lisbon - 8 Days Itinerary

DAY 1: Transfer in

Welcome to Madeira, a stunning island situated in the Atlantic Ocean. Known for its natural beauty, diverse landscapes, and rich cultural heritage, Madeira offers an unforgettable experience to all who visit.



DAY 2: Eira do Serrado, Pico dos Barcelos & Cristo Rei Group Journey

This scenic excursion begins at Pico dos Barcelos, where you'll take in panoramic views over Funchal, framed by the sea and surrounding hills. From there, we climb higher into the mountains to reach Eira do Serrado, an impressive viewpoint offering breathtaking vistas over Curral das Freiras—the secluded “Valley of the Nuns.”

We'll then descend into the heart of Curral das Freiras, a peaceful and picturesque village nestled in a dramatic volcanic crater, perfect for a stroll and a taste of local charm.

The tour continues through the eastern side of the island, ending at the beautiful Cristo Rei viewpoint, where the iconic statue stands overlooking the Atlantic Ocean—a peaceful spot with stunning coastal scenery.

A short but rich journey, filled with majestic landscapes and authentic Madeira charm.



DAY 3: Porto Moniz Coastal Wonders – Group Journey

On this, probably the most popular excursion of the Island, you will visit the Fishing Villages of Câmara de Lobos and Ribeira Brava, travel along the south west coast as far as Calheta and climb the mountains to Paul da Serra (the famous mountain plateau).

From the plateau, you will descend to the north coast and the Village of Porto Moniz, famed for its volcanic rock swimming pools before experiencing the breathtaking drive along the infamous cliff hugging north coast road to São Vicente.

From this pretty Village you will turn inland and travel up through a lush valley region to the mountain pass of Encumeada and on finally to Cabo Girão.





DAY 4: Transfer to Lisbon

Welcome to Portugal and the city of Lisbon, capital of the country. After settling into the hotel day will be free to explore the city.

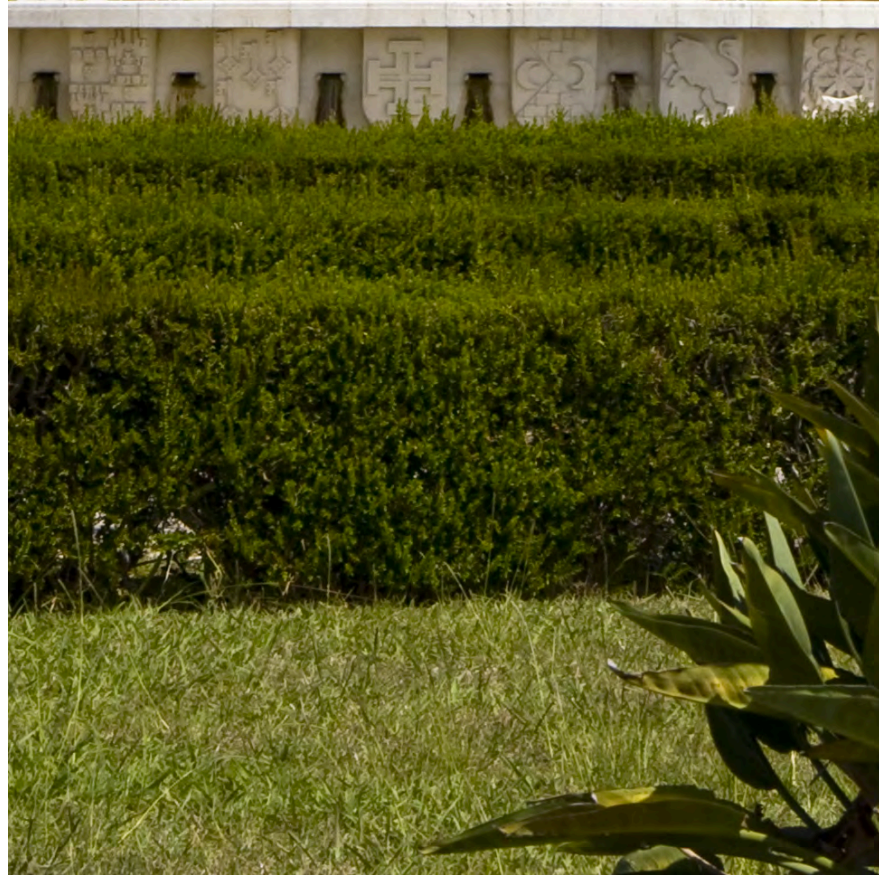


DAY 5: Belém Discoveries by Tuk Tuk

Embark on a 3-hour tuk tuk journey to Belém, the district forever linked to Portugal's Golden Age of Discoveries. With hotel pick-up included, the tour leads you through the heart of Lisbon's maritime heritage, where caravels once set sail to explore new worlds.

Here you'll admire some of Lisbon's most iconic landmarks: the grand Jerónimos Monastery, a symbol of the Manueline style; the striking Monument to the Discoveries, celebrating the navigators who expanded the known world; and the riverside Belém Tower, one of the city's most photographed sites.

To complete the experience, step into the historic Pastéis de Belém factory to taste the original custard tart, paired with a glass of traditional Ginjinha.



DAY 6: Sintra Palaces & Gardens, Wine & Cascais Group Journey



Embark on an unforgettable journey from Lisbon to discover the breathtaking beauty of Sintra, Cabo da Roca, and Cascais, in an experience that blends history, culture, and fine wine.

Your adventure begins in Lisbon, heading towards the enchanting town of Sintra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stroll through its picturesque streets and admire the harmony between lush greenery and the town's historic architecture.

The highlight of your visit will be the Park and Gardens of Pena Palace, one of Europe's most remarkable Romantic landmarks. Perched on the mountaintop, the palace captivates with its vibrant exterior and eclectic blend of architectural styles, evoking the magic of a fairy tale.

In the surrounding gardens, you'll find serene trails and scenic viewpoints offering breathtaking panoramic vistas.

Next, continue to the dramatic Cabo da Roca, the westernmost point of mainland Europe. Here, towering cliffs meet the vast Atlantic Ocean, creating awe-inspiring views and a perfect opportunity to connect with the raw power of nature.
