



DAY 2: Peña de Bernal & Vineyard Experience in Querétaro Wine Country

Today, venture outside the city to explore the magic town of Bernal, home to one of the tallest monoliths in the world — Peña de Bernal. Stroll the cobbled streets beneath this mystical rock formation, browse local crafts, and soak in the peaceful atmosphere.

Afterward, enjoy a scenic drive through the Querétaro wine region, one of Mexico's emerging viticulture hotspots. DAY 3: Scenic Cultural Transfer to San Miguel de Allende

Rather than a direct drive, your private transfer includes curated stops in heritage towns and local vineyards, offering a deeper sense of place.

- Ezequiel Montes
- Begin your day with a visit to one of the region's renowned vineyards like Freixenet México or Viñedos La Redonda for a short cellar tour and wine tasting, with the option to purchase regional wines or cheeses for the road.
- Tequisquiapan
- Continue to this charming Pueblo Mágico, where you can stroll the main square, shop for handmade crafts, or enjoy a light lunch at a local café under colonial arcades.
- Comonfort (Optional Detour)
- Visit this artisan town known for handcarved molcajetes and indigenous Otomí traditions. This quiet stop offers a chance to support local artists and experience true off-the-beaten-path culture.
- Atotonilco (UNESCO Site)

Just before arriving in San Miguel, stop at the Sanctuary of Atotonilco, a baroque masterpiece often called the "Sistine Chapel of Mexico." Learn about its role in Mexico's independence and admire the stunning murals inside.



By late afternoon, you'll arrive in San Miguel de Allende, where your boutique hotel awaits in the heart of the historic center. The evening is yours to relax or enjoy an optional rooftop cocktail while watching the sunset over the iconic pink spires of the Parroquia.

boutiques.


After the city exploration, enjoy a **private vineyard visit** where you'll taste carefully selected regional wines paired with a gourmet lunch in an intimate setting.


The afternoon offers leisure time to relax or take part in optional experiences such as a **Talavera tile painting workshop** or a **mezcal tasting.**

DAY 7: Transfer from San Miguel to Guanajuato via Atotonilco & Dolores Hidalgo

- First, visit the Sanctuary of Atotonilco, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often called the "Sistine Chapel of Mexico" for its elaborate baroque murals. This 18thcentury church played a significant role during Mexico's War of Independence.
- Then, continue to Dolores Hidalgo, the cradle of Mexican independence. Explore the historic church where Father Miguel Hidalgo gave the famous "Grito de Dolores" that sparked the revolution in 1810. While there, don't miss a stop for some of the town's famous artisan ice cream and talavera pottery.

After your tour, enjoy a scenic drive into Guanajuato, where you'll check into your boutique hotel.

In the evening, experience a Callejoneada — a festive and interactive musical parade through the city's narrow alleys, led by traditional student performers (tunas) who share songs, jokes, and local legends. It's a joyful way to dive into Guanajuato's vibrant spirit.

DAY 8: Walking Tour of Guanajuato – Legends, Landmarks & Local Life

Today, dive deeper into the spirit of **Guanajuato** with a **private walking tour** through its colorful, colonial streets — many of which are pedestrian-only, perfect for discovering hidden gems on foot.

Your expert local guide will take you through:

- Plaza de la Paz The heart of the city, surrounded by colorful colonial mansions and the majestic Basilica of Our Lady of Guanajuato
- Alley of the Kiss (Callejón del Beso)
 Discover the romantic legend behind this famously narrow alleyway
- **Teatro Juárez** An architectural gem with a rich cultural history
- University of Guanajuato A stunning neoclassical building that reflects the city's academic legacy
- El Jardín de la Unión A tree-lined plaza filled with mariachi music and local life

Throughout the tour, enjoy stories of Guanajuato's role in Mexico's War of Independence, its mining heritage, and the legends that give this city so much character.

DAY 9: Scenic Transfer to Mexico City via Tula or Tepotzotlán

DAY 10: Historic Mexico City Walking Tour

DAY 11: Frida Kahlo's Casa Azul, Coyoacán & Xochimilco Canals

Next, explore the leafy, bohemian district of **Coyoacán**, filled with cobbled streets, artisanal markets, and colonial charm. Your guide will highlight key spots, and you'll have time to explore or enjoy lunch at a local favorite.

In the afternoon, head south to the UNESCO-designated canals of **Xochimilco**, the last vestiges of the city's pre-Hispanic lake system. Board a colorful **trajinera** (traditional wooden boat) and cruise the floating gardens to the sound of live mariachi music and local flavors. This festive, one-of-a-kind experience brings Mexico's ancient and modern cultures together in vibrant harmony.

DAY 12: Final Reflections at Teotihuacán & Basilica of Guadalupe

Walk along the **Avenue of the Dead**, admire the **Pyramid of the Sun and Moon**, and learn about the society that predated the Aztecs.




