After settling into the hotel day will be free to explore the city.






DAY 2: Belém Discoveries

To complete the experience, step into the historic Pastéis de Belém factory to taste the original custard tart, paired with a glass of traditional Ginjinha.

DAY 4: Fátima, Nazaré & Óbidos

DAY 5: Évora Heritage & Wine Group Journey




You'll tour the facilities, learn about the production process, and enjoy a guided tasting of wines that reflect the richness and balance typical of Alentejo's terroir—a perfect way to end a day of history, discovery, and flavor.






DAY 6: Free Day
