




Madeira Island - 7 Days Itinerary

DAY 1: Transfer to Madeira Island

The tour continues through the eastern side of the island, ending at the beautiful Cristo Rei viewpoint, where the iconic statue stands overlooking the Atlantic Ocean—a peaceful spot with stunning coastal scenery.

DAY 3: Porto Moniz Coastal Wonders – Group Journey

On this, probably the most popular excursion of the Island, you will visit the Fishing Villages of Câmara de Lobos and Ribeira Brava, travel along the south west coast as far as Calheta and climb the mountains to Paul da Serra (the famous mountain plateau).

From the plateau, you will descend to the north coast and the Village of Porto Moniz, famed for its volcanic rock swimming pools before experiencing the breathtaking drive along the infamous cliff hugging north coast road to São Vicente.

From this pretty Village you will turn inland and travel up through a lush valley region to the mountain pass of Encumeada and on finally to Cabo Girão.





DAY 4: Leisure in Madeira

This day is yours to enjoy exactly as you wish. Relax by the pool, take a leisurely stroll through Funchal's botanical gardens, or discover hidden corners of the island at your own pace.

DAY 5: Santana & Camacha

Next, we head to Santana, famous for its iconic A-framed cottages, a true symbol of Madeira's traditional architecture. The journey continues along the stunning north coast, taking in the picturesque villages of Porto da Cruz and Portela, where you'll be treated to dramatic mountain scenery.

We then stop in Machico, the historic spot where the island's discoverers first set foot, before ending the day in Camacha. A delightful day of discovery, scenery, and culture awaits!
