DAY 4: Aveiro Half Day Tour

DAY 5: Braga & Guimarães Shared


Departing from Porto, embark on a memorable journey through two of Portugal's most historic cities.

As one of the oldest cities in Portugal, founded by the Romans as Bracara Augusta, Braga is rich in history. Stroll through its charming historic center with your guide and explore the Sé de Braga, the country's oldest cathedral, showcasing a blend of Romanesque, Gothic, and Baroque styles. Don't miss the Jardim de Santa Bárbara, a picturesque retreat surrounded by the ruins of the Archiepiscopal Palace, where colorful flowers and medieval architecture create a fairy-tale setting.

Before returning to Porto, soak in the atmosphere at Praça da Oliveira, a lively square lined with historic buildings, charming cafés, and the striking Gothic Church of Nossa Senhora da Oliveira.
